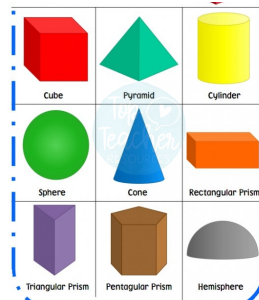
Collect 8-10 objects from around your home.

Use the name of the object to introduce your object.

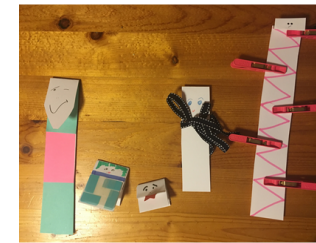
Make sure you have at least one of every 3D Object.

How many short creatures are needed to be the same height as the taller creature?

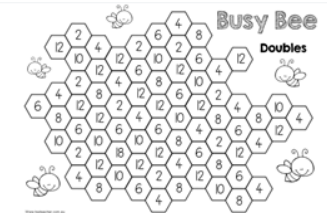
Draw a picture to show you measuring how tall the creature is that you just measured

If you get 3 in a row, you win!

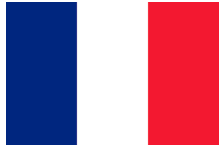
