



Alphabet Scavenger Hunt

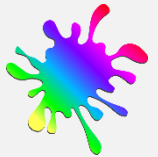
Use these ideas to complete different scavenger hunts with your family



<p><u>Home Objects</u></p> <p>Can you collect/think of 26 natural items, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet?</p>	<p><u>Nature</u></p> <p>Can you come up with or find 26 natural objects, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet?</p>	<p><u>Names</u></p> <p>Can you come up with a list of 26 animals, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet?</p>	<p><u>Cars</u></p> <p>Can you come up with a list of 26 cars, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet?</p>
<p><u>Books</u></p> <p>Can you find at home or think of 26 books, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet?</p>	<p><u>Cooking Ingredients</u></p> <p>Can you find 26 different cooking ingredients each starting with a different letter of the alphabet?</p>	<p><u>Tools / Utensils</u></p> <p>Can you 26 different tools / utensils in your home, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet.</p>	<p><u>Toys</u></p> <p>Can you find 26 different toys in your house, each starting with a different letter of the alphabet – it could be the name of the toy or the name you have given it.</p>
