Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers

We have had a relatively good start to the year with some new staff and a large number of lovely new families.

Firstly, I do apologise for the information regarding the coronavirus which changed over the few days we commenced school. I modified our last week's Newsletter and re-sent it. The website has also been modified to reflect the Departments instructions. The latest information is updated onto the DET website so this is the most up-to-date information for you. The 14 day exclusion has been heeded by all our families who travelled to China over the holidays and I wish to thank them for their diligence and compliance with this. They have been amazing!

Our classes were formed on day 1 and there is very little room for movement with this due to our numbers. We made some changes in the last weeks of school to ensure that Years 1 and 2 were not in very big classes. I understand that there has been some hesitation regarding the formation of composite classes but can assure you that the children in these classes thrive as much as in any other class. The staff engaged in training and in the creating of lessons to teach and model these expectations to our students. The lessons were created to be appropriate for each year group and are retaught throughout the year. This week I have included our Playground Expectations for you to be familiar with. When students do not follow these expectations, they are issued with a Pink Slip. The data we collect from these Pink Slips helps the staff determine which expectation/s need to be retaught. Students are continuously rewarded with POWLS for

following the expectations, which are put towards achieving Bronze Awards and ultimately a School Medal.
