Junior Band

Junior Band starts in week 3. All students should have picked up their instruments and have had at least one tutorial prior to the first Junior Band rehearsals in week 3. If you do not have a tutor, please contact Mr Rowland for assistance via email (tpsbands@outlook.com).

Junior Band will be separated into two groups from week 3 until after Band Camp as follows:

- Brass (trumpet, trombone, euphonium, horn, bass guitar and tuba) will start rehearsal before school on Tuesday starting on 9 February at 7.50am 8.50am.
- Woodwind (flute, clarinet and saxophone) will start rehearsal on Wednesday 10 February from 3.15pm

Ethics classes at Turramurra Public School

Dear Parents and Carers,

Could you be an ethics teacher for Turramurra Public School?

We are seeking volunteers so that we can provide ethics classes for all the families who have requested it for their children.

Ethics teachers receive full training by Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the ethics program. Training consists of a two-day workshop and short online modules. Lesson materials are provided. Suitable volunteers have an interest in children's education and development of critical thinking skills and must be available at 9:15am or 10:25am on Wednesday each week.

In ethics classes, children learn how to think logically, disagree respectfully and support their arguments with evidence, rather than act according to blind habit or peer pressure.

Children discuss topic such as:

- -Imagining how others feel
- -How do we treat living things?
- -What is laziness?
- -How do we disagree in a respectful way?
- -Fairness




