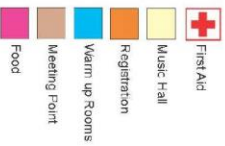
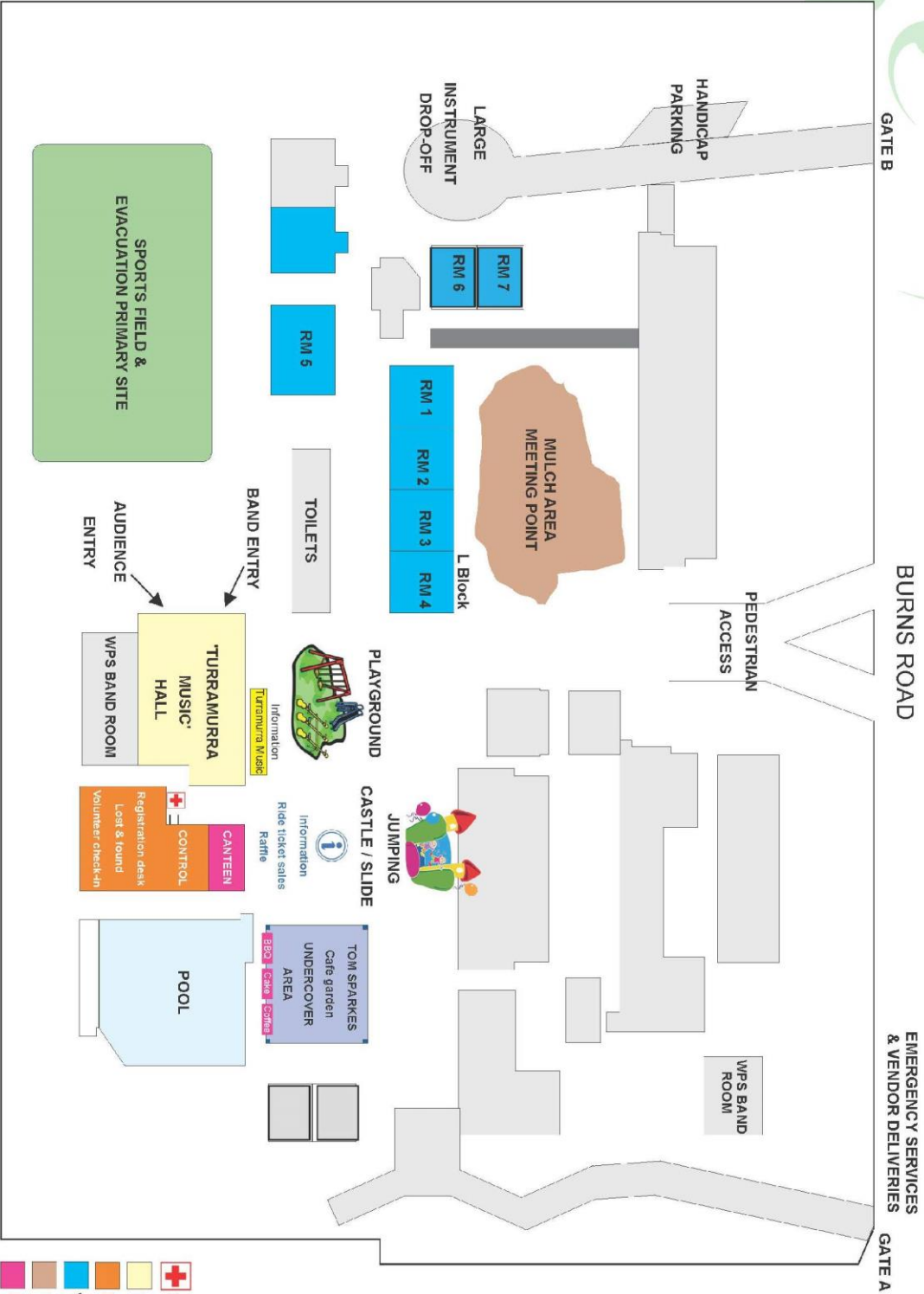

An attendant will be in place to give participants access and directions. An area will be available at the Control Room for instruments to be held until your warm up room is available. A receipt will be issued for all instrument minding and must be produced to enable collection. **Warm up rooms** are provided. Please note, however, they are teaching rooms so please respect the items of the children and teachers who use that classroom. **NO FOOD** is allowed in the warm up rooms. Please ensure that your band returns directly to the warm up room after their performance and vacates the room in a timely manner, according to the schedule given.
