Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers

A reminder for Year 4 parents that the online applications for OC classes close on Friday, June 26th. There will be no late entries and the application will all be dependent on the test that the children sit. This is due to the late completion due to COVID restrictions.

Many activities will resume next Term. The activities are:


