Welcome back everyone.

I return to School tomorrow after a lovely holiday in Russia I even managed to see some students in Finland which was amazing. Our families certainly travel widely as well!!

Our Staff returned to School on Monday and spent the morning researching ways to increase creativity and critical thinking in their classrooms. The presenter spoke of the importance in developing students imaginations, citing the example, *You may teach a student to be a great coder but with no imagination what can you do with the coding skill.* The teachers investigated the process of using the visual mind and imagination to then developing creativity and experimenting with different ideas, which ultimately results in innovative thinking.

Today Kindergarten celebrated 100 days of school. Each student bought a collection of 100. Students designed and made a hat as part of the celebration. It is a significant milestone for our Kindergarten Students in their first year at TPS. Students participated in a variety of activities consolidating their Maths skills.
