Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers

We are already at the halfway point of the Term and there are a lot of activities planned for our students. Year 6 will have a taste of High School next Wednesday when the High School will send teachers to address them in the Hall. The Orientation Session at the High School is on December 1st invitations have been sent to all students who have enrolled for Turramurra High School, please contact the High School If you have not received one. Other schools will also have Orientation Sessions and parents should look out for these.

Thank you to Mr Rowland for his work with the Band. Our Band atudents are performing at lunchtimes on a Friday. I attended last week's session and it was wonderful. Year 2 were invited to come and listen as part of their introduction to what the Band looks and sounds like. They really enjoyed the opportunity to attend.

The Government has produced a new resource for all parents on the eight effective practices of 'What Works Best.' This resource will be available on the parent hub of the Department's website from November 18th. The resource looks very useful. Our teachers have had intensive training this year in all eight elements.

The OC Test will be conducted at our School tomorrow morning from 9am. All applicants must arrive at the 2/3R classroom at 9am. 2/3R students will work elsewhere for the time of the test. If your child is sitting the test please be on time. This is 5 minutes before the start of school for all others but we are unable to vary the time of the test as all schools must finish at the same time. Students are able to bring a drink bottle with them and any medications such as asthma puffers.

The "Toys 'n' Tucker" collection starts this week. All classrooms will have a collection box and we ask that you donate non-perishable food and new toys as you see fit. The boxes will be collected on December 11th. We will send reminders closer to the collection date.
